REFLECTION FOR THE FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER



In today's Gospel, Jesus says, 'My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me'. Yet, this is precisely where we often struggle. We are easily distracted, caught up in the noise of daily life, and not always attentive to the voice of the Shepherd. True listening is an act of the heart and mind; it requires silence, patience, and perseverance.

We are invited to return again and again to the Gospels, to read, to reflect, and to allow God's Word to penetrate deeply into our lives, so we can hear God's voice more clearly.

Christ's voice becomes clearer when we give Him the time and space to speak. Little by little, through prayer and reflection, we begin to recognise His voice... leading us, guiding us, and reassuring us that we are never alone under the care of the Good Shepherd.
